- In this list, pharmacies with a green **90** next to them are approved to fill **both 90-day and 30 day** prescriptions.
- The other pharmacies listed here are only approved to fill a **30-day** supply.

What you need to know about your pharmacy network

- Every pharmacy is approved to fill **30-day** prescriptions.
- Select pharmacies, including **Walgreens**, are approved to fill **90-day** (or 3-month) prescriptions.³
- **All 90-day prescriptions** must be filled at an in-network retail pharmacy approved to fill that amount or through home delivery with Express Scripts® Pharmacy.⁴



90-day supplies help make refills easier.

- You'll make fewer trips to the pharmacy for refills (four times a year instead of every month).
- And with more medication at home, you're less likely to run out and miss a dose.

Important reminder about 90-day prescriptions

If you fill a 90-day (or 3-month) prescription,³ you must use a retail pharmacy approved to fill that amount or home delivery with Express Scripts Pharmacy.⁴

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q. What's Cigna 90 Now?

A. It's a program that lets you choose where you want to fill 90-day (or 3-month) prescriptions³ for maintenance medications: at select in-network retail pharmacies or through home delivery with Express Scripts Pharmacy.⁴

For some plans, you can choose to fill maintenance medications in a 30-day or 90-day supply;³ for others, you may have to fill maintenance medications in a 90-day supply. Log in to the myCigna app or myCigna.com to see how your plan covers maintenance medications.

Q. What are maintenance medications?

A. These are medications you take on a regular basis to treat an ongoing health condition such as asthma, diabetes, high blood pressure or high cholesterol. They're not used to treat a short-term condition such as an infection or pain caused by surgery or a broken bone.

Q. Can I choose to fill my maintenance medication in a 30-day supply instead of a 90-day supply?

A. It depends on the Cigna 90 Now program your plan has. Some plans require you to fill maintenance medications in a 90-day supply to be covered; others don't. Log in to the myCigna app or **myCigna.com**, or check your plan materials, to learn more about how your plan covers maintenance medications.

Q. Can any type of medication be filled in a 90-day supply?

A. You don't usually fill medications that treat short-term conditions (such as infections or pain caused by surgery or a broken bone), narcotic pain medications (also known as opioids) and most specialty medications (which treat rare and/or complex medical conditions) in a 90-day supply.

Q. I have a 90-day prescription for a specialty medication. Do I have to use one of the pharmacies with a green 90 next to it?

A. No. The Cigna 90 Now program doesn't apply to specialty medications. However, your plan may require you to fill your medication at a certain pharmacy or through Accredo.⁴ Please check your plan materials to see how your plan covers specialty medications.

Q. Where can I fill a 30-day prescription?

A. You can use any retail pharmacy in your plan's network.

Q. Where can I fill a 90-day prescription?

A. You can use select retail pharmacies in your plan's network or home delivery with Express Scripts Pharmacy.⁴

Q. Can I fill my 30-day prescriptions at the same retail pharmacy I get my 90-day supply from?

A. Yes. **All** in-network retail pharmacies can fill 30-day prescriptions. Only certain retail pharmacies are approved to fill 90-day prescriptions.

Q. Can I fill a 90-day prescription at any pharmacy in my network?

A. No. For your plan to cover a 90-day supply, **you must use** an in-network retail pharmacy that's approved to fill that amount or Express Scripts Pharmacy. In this directory, retail pharmacies that are approved to fill 90-day supplies have a green **90** next to them.

Q. Can I fill a 90-day prescription at CVS?

A. With Cigna 90 Now, 90-day fills aren't covered at both CVS and Walgreens. Since your plan covers 90-day fills at Walgreens, this means that CVS is only approved to fill 30-day supplies. If you choose to fill a 90-day supply at CVS, your medication won't be covered.⁵

Q. Why should I fill a 90-day supply?

A. You'll make fewer trips to the pharmacy for refills (just four times a year instead of every month). And with more medication at home, you're less likely to run out and miss a dose.

Q. Will I save money by filling a 90-day supply?

A. It depends on your plan. Log in to the myCigna app or **myCigna.com**, or check your plan materials, to learn more about your plan's copay or coinsurance for 90-day fills.

Q. I'm currently filling my medication in a 30-day supply. Do I need my doctor's okay to switch to a 90-day supply?

A. Yes. You'll need a new prescription for a 90-day (or 3-month) supply.³

Q. I want to fill a 90-day supply, but my current prescription is only for 30-days. How do I fill a larger amount?

A. Call your doctor's office and ask them for a new prescription for a 90-day (or 3-month) supply. Then, ask them to send it to an in-network pharmacy that's approved to fill that amount.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) (cont.)

Q. My medication doesn't come in a 90-day supply. What does that mean for me?

A. Not all medications come in a 90-day supply. For example, oral contraceptives come in a 3-pack, which is an 84-day supply. It's important to know that even though it's not a full "90-day supply," we still think of it as a 90-day prescription.

Q. I have a 90-day prescription, but my retail pharmacy isn't approved to fill 90-day supplies.

How do I switch pharmacies?

A. Here are two easy ways to move your prescription:

1. Call your doctor's office. Ask them to send your 90-day prescription to your new retail pharmacy. Or,

2. If your prescription still has a refill available, ask the pharmacist at your new pharmacy to contact your current pharmacy to help move your prescription.

Q. Can I fill my maintenance medication in a 90-day supply through Express Scripts Pharmacy?

A. Yes, as long as your plan allows.⁴ Express Scripts Pharmacy is a convenient option when you're taking a medication on a regular basis to treat an ongoing health condition. It's simple and safe, and saves you trips to the pharmacy. To learn more, go to Cigna.com/homedelivery.

- Easily order, manage, track and pay for your medications on your phone or online.
- Get standard shipping at no extra cost.⁶
- Fill up to a 90-day supply at one time.³
- Talk with a pharmacist, 24/7.

- Sign up for automatic refills or refill reminders so you don't miss a dose.⁷
- Use a payment plan (if you need it).

Here are two easy ways to get started using home delivery:

1. Online.

Log in to the myCigna app or myCigna.com and click on the Prescriptions tab. Choose My Medications from the dropdown list. Then click the button next to your medication name to move your prescription(s) from your retail pharmacy to home delivery. Or,

2. By phone.

- Call your doctor's office. Ask them to send a 90-day prescription (with refills) to Express Scripts home delivery. Or,
- Call Express Scripts Pharmacy at **800.835.3784**. They'll contact your doctor's office to get your prescription. Have your ID card, doctor's contact information and medication name(s) ready when you call.

Q. Can Express Scripts Pharmacy help move my prescription to their pharmacy?

A. Yes. Just call **800.835.3784** and have your Cigna Healthcare ID card, doctor's contact information and medication name(s) ready when you call. Express Scripts Pharmacy will do the rest.

3. Some medications aren't available in a 90-day supply and may only be packaged in lesser amounts. For example, oral contraceptives come in a 3-pack, which is an 84-day supply. It's important to know that even though it's not a full "90-day supply," we still think of it as a 90-day prescription.

4. Not all plans offer Express Scripts Pharmacy as a covered pharmacy option. Log in to the myCigna app or myCigna.com, or check your plan materials, to learn more about the pharmacies in your plan's network. Cigna Healthcare, Evernorth Health Services and Express Scripts Pharmacy are all part of The Cigna Group. This means we have an ownership interest in these pharmacies; However, you have the right to fill prescriptions at any pharmacy in your plan's network (as your plan allows).

5. If your plan offers out-of-network coverage, you'll pay your out-of-network cost-share to fill a prescription at CVS. If your plan doesn't offer out-of-network coverage, your medication won't be covered at all. Log in to the myCigna app or myCigna.com to learn more about your plan's out-of-network coverage.

6. Your plan pays the cost for standard shipping.

7. Express Scripts Pharmacy can automatically refill certain medications. Log in to the myCigna app or myCigna.com or call 800.835.3784 to sign up. You can sign up to get emails and/or texts from Express Scripts Pharmacy. To get text messages, you'll have to sign up for the Express Scripts texting service. You can do this online or over the phone. Once you sign up, simply reply to their welcome text to get started. Standard text messaging rates apply.
